Swimming Pool Rules

The Club Managers and staff are given full authority to enforce all swimming pool rules and to change or adjust these rules for the safety of the participants.

- A. Lifeguards will request your name to register you and your guests prior to swimming. Members may be asked to verify address or provide I.D.
- B. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a person over 14.
- C. Children will be issued bands and may give street number and address as id.
- D. Children who are wearing flotation devices must be accompanied by a parent or person 14 years old or over and supervised at all times.
- E. Lifeguards are not babysitters. Children must be closely supervised at all times by a parent or babysitter whether in or out of the pools.
- F. No diving in any area of the pool is permitted. (Other than in the competition pool during swim practice or swim meets.)
- G. Children wearing diapers must wear swim diapers or appropriate rubber pants under suit. Diapers disintegrate in the pool and can pose a sanitation problem **which may close the pool for the day.**
- H. Foul or abusive language, glass or smoking will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion or suspension of Club privileges.
- I. The following are not permitted within the fenced area of the pool or clubhouse: large inflatable rafts, pets, unruly behavior or running.
- J. No playing allowed in the lap lanes. No cutting through lap lanes.
- K. No cut off shorts allowed in the pool.
- L. Swim masks, snorkels and fins will not be allowed in the pool unless first approved by a lifeguard or pool manager. Parents must stay with their children when using these items.
- M. The Club will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- N. The management has the right and responsibility to close the pool when necessary.
- O. Persons entering the pool after closing time will be trespassing and subject to arrest.
- P. Management has the right to ask any person they consider unruly or intoxicated to leave the premises.
- Q. Management reserves the right to deny admittance or escort out anyone who is violating any stated rule.
- R. Wet bathing suits are not permitted in the fitness center.



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Slide Rules

The Club Managers and staff are given full authority to enforce all slide rules and to change or adjust these rules for the safety of the participants.

- A. Swimmers must stay clear of the catch pool and slide exit area. They must exit the catch pool immediately.
- B. Children who are 48 inches tall or have demonstrated swimming ability must use the slide by themselves.
- C. Children less than 42 inches tall and who are unable to swim may use the slide only with a parent or babysitter.
- D. No flotation devices of any kind are permitted on the slide.
- E. Only one person at a time allowed down the slide. (Excluding adult and small child.)
- F. No diving from the slide into the catch pool upon exiting the flume.
- G. Walk up the steps and make sure the catch pool is empty before beginning your slide run.
- H. Although parents may retrieve their children from the water if necessary, they should take care not to stand in front of the slide in order to avoid any possible collision and not attempt to catch their child as they exit the slide.
- I. Riders must go down on their back and feet first.
- J. No wading on the steps or in the catch pool.
- K. Do not stop or block the flow of water from the slide.
- L. No balls or toys on the water slide.
- M. No masks permitted on the slide.

Guest Policy and Passes

- A. Skybrook residents who are not Club members are not allowed guest privileges and are not permitted to use the club's facilities. Any member bringing unauthorized non-members could have their membership terminated.
- B. Guests must be accompanied by an adult member.
- C. Guests are subject to the \$5 per person guest fee on weekends at Skybrook Main ONLY. Prior to July 10th no guests at **Skybrook North** on weekends or holidays.
- D. Each membership family may bring up to two guests per day for free during the week with the exception of holidays and weekends. After July 10th, no charge on weekends, holidays do not apply.
- E. Only out-of-town house guest may be guests on holidays and weekends in May and June. Guest fees will apply and ID is required for those 16 and above.
- F. Guests must be accompanied by the member at all times.
- G. All guests must register upon entry to the facility.



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- H. Guest fees are published and are subject to change by the Club. Children 4 years old and under are not required to pay a guest fee. Anyone entering the pool area or tennis courts may be required to pay a guest fee regardless if they will be using the pool or tennis courts, or not.
- I. All guests 16 and over will be required to show a valid photo I.D. or driver's license. It is your responsibility to make sure guests have their I.D. or driver's license with them upon entering.
- J. Guest fees apply to each guest per day and will be collected at the check-in table.

Guest Passes

If you plan on having many guests this summer, you may want to consider purchasing a bulk guest pass. Individual guest passes are \$5.00 each for the pool and tennis courts. However, you can purchase a bulk pass for \$35.00 which allows for 10 visit passes. Any unused passes will not carry over to the next swim season. Guest passes can be purchased at the lifeguard station during normal pool hours. Please pay with checks or cash.

Babysitter and Nanny Passes

Nannies and babysitters will be allowed to accompany children to the pools for no additional fee. They are not allowed to use the facilities otherwise.
